STANDING ORDER REGARDING SCHEDULING BOND MOTIONS

Pursuant to the provisions of O.C.G.A. §17-6-1, all motions for bond before Superior Court shall be scheduled as follows:

- a) Motions to set bond shall be placed on the next available motion calendar before any superior court judge. All motions to set bond shall be set for a date within ten days after the receipt of the petition. In the event the assigned judge has a court date within ten days of receipt of the petition, the bond motion to set bond shall be set for that judge's motion calendar.
- b) Motions to reduce or modify bond shall be scheduled before the judge to whom the case is assigned. Unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties, any motion to reduce or modify bond shall be set on the next available calendar for the assigned judge.
- c) Once a case is indicted or accused, all motions regarding bond shall be set before the assigned judge unless otherwise permitted by the assigned judge.
- d) Motions to revoke bond shall be scheduled before the assigned judge.
- e) Motions for bond on violations of probation shall be scheduled before the judge who is assigned to hear the probation revocation hearing.
