STANDING ORDER ON CASELOAD REPORTING

Whereas, in order to assist the Administrative Office of the Courts in their duties owed to the courts of this circuit pursuant to and under the several provisions of O.C.G.A. § 15-5-24; and

Whereas, it is within this court's authority to require the reporting of extensive caseload data to the Chief Judge of said court under Uniform Rule 39.9; and

Whereas, it is essential to the functioning of this court that accurate and complete information be provided; and

Whereas, historically the chief judge has been provided this information to assist the clerks in the correct, complete, and accurate reporting of such data to the Administrative Office of the Clerks, now, therefore;

It is ordered that each of the Clerks of Superior Courts of Barrow and Jackson Counties provide to the Chief Judge of the Circuit those data elements required by the Administrative Office of the Courts on an annual basis no later than ten (10) days prior to the submission to the Administrative Office of the Courts. That data shall include all elements required to be reported to the Administrative Office of the Courts, including but not limited to the number of total criminal filings, the number of misdemeanor filings, the number of felony filings, the number of serious felony filings, the number of criminal dispositions, the number of probation revocation filings, the total number of civil filings and dispositions, the number of general civil filings and

dispositions, and the number of domestic civil filings and dispositions. Furthermore, the Clerks shall provide this data once per quarter to the Chief Judge of the Circuit.¹

Let each of the Clerks report this Standing Order on the minutes of the Court.


