STANDING ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS FOR NEW TRIAL


Pursuant to the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 5-5-40 and U.S.C.R. 41.2, all motions for new trial before the Superior Court shall be scheduled as follows:


- (a) All motions for new trial shall be filed within 30 days of the entry of the judgment on the verdict or entry of the judgment where the case was tried without a jury and be served upon the State and the Court.
- (b) The motion may be amended any time on or before the ruling thereon; provided, however, that in criminal proceedings when the Defendant substantially amends his or her motion for new trial and serves said motion upon the State, the State shall be given ten days to respond and present evidence.
- (c) Upon the filing of a motion for new trial and service of said motion upon the State, the State shall schedule a status conference regarding the motion for new trial no later than 120 days after sentencing.
- (d) The Court shall schedule status conferences regarding the motion for new trial no less than every 180 days after the first conference until the motion for new trial is heard.






